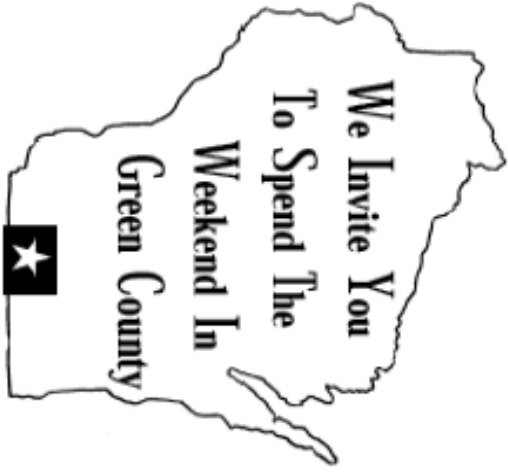

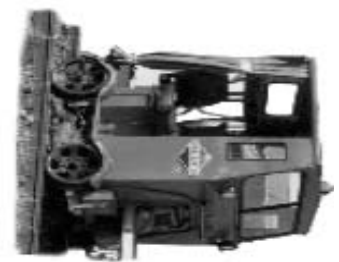

Learn more about our railroading heritage and local history. Enjoy an opportunity to ride a “Speeder Car”, the maintenance cars of the railroads.

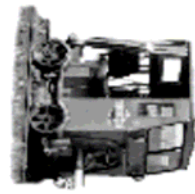
Explore the Brooklyn area and meet and greet your fellow “Geocachers”. Saturday only.

Downtown at the railroad tracks:

2. We’ve filled upstairs and downstairs with Model Railroad displays, including a wooden train set on train table for the kids to operate.
3. Methodist Church concessions and bake sale downstairs.
4. **New Location:** “Collect the Art” of Depot Days, artists will be there to discuss and sell their creations. These artists work in a variety of mediums and styles, all local talent.

5. **New-** pick-up your coordinates and register your poker “Showdown” hand for our GPS based Geocaching event.

Downtown flea market:

Throughout the downtown booths will be set-up on the sidewalks for a spring get the dust off/out flea market.
